

Selected KEY RECOMMENDATIONS



- Promoting a resilient, green and inclusive economic recovery from COVID-19
- Ensure effective use of EU funding for environmentrelated infrastructure
- Phase-out lignite by 2028 and support the transition in lignite-dependent areas; pursue island interconnection and invest in renewables and storage systems
- Ensure that water, agriculture and tourism policies factor in climate change impacts
- Further integrate biodiversity concerns into economic sectors; support sustainable tourism

Selected KEY RECOMMENDATIONS

OECD

- Close illegal landfills, build treatment facilities for hazardous waste
- Adopt the air pollution control programme to protect human health
- Align fiscal incentives with environmental objectives; phase out fossil fuel subsidies while protecting those in need
- Strengthen environmental inspection authorities
- Improve environmental monitoring and information









ALIGN taxes with environmental objectives


Share of

2018









